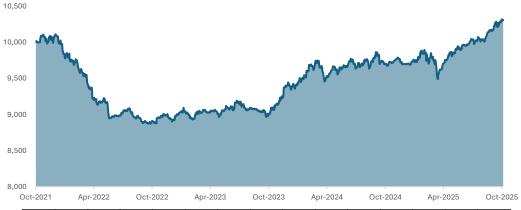


# Concepts & Objectives

This FCP (Fonds Commun de Placement) investment strategy consists in dynamically selecting equity and rates indices related to developed economies. The strategy aims for a "smooth investment journey" (ie low volatility) over a recommended investment period greater than 3 years associated with a low market sensitivity. The fund is long-only with no leverage. The strategy takes into account clearly defined ESG criteria described in the prospectus consistent with SFDR Art.8

# Monthly comments

In October, the fund returned a positive performance of +1.19% bringing its year-to-date net performance to +6.26%.

We closed September wondering how challenging it might be for the Federal Reserve to interpret the current state of the U.S. economy—and entered October amid a U.S. government shutdown. This certainly hasn't made the Fed's job any easier. Despite this backdrop, the Federal Reserve cut rates by another 25 bps this month, citing a weakening labor market. However, Chair Jerome Powell signaled that additional cuts in December are far from guaranteed. But the real strong signal is the end of quantitative tightening as of December 1. A new measure of support for the markets. On the equity side, our exposure to Japanese equities was the best performer this month. Optimism following the election of new Prime Minister Sanae Tachedi boosted the entire stock market in Japan. That said, Japanese rates continue to rise, while the yen has weakened significantly against both the euro and the U.S. dollar. Meanwhile, geopolitical developments—including Trump's regional visits—added to market dynamics. The final week of October was dominated by strong tech-sector earnings. Investors remain committed to AI, but expectations have shifted toward clearer and faster returns on substantial investments with potential challenges at financing capex. Throughout the month, we opted to reduce equity exposure and approach year-end with a more balanced stance. While equities have reached new all-time highs in the U.S. and other major economies, signs of a gradual deterioration in the U.S. labor market persist, with layoffs rising and hiring growth slowing down while inflation remains around 3%. Historically, November has been a favorable month for the stock market. However, this year has brought its own set of challenges, prompting us to adopt a resilient and balanced approach to keep volatility under control.

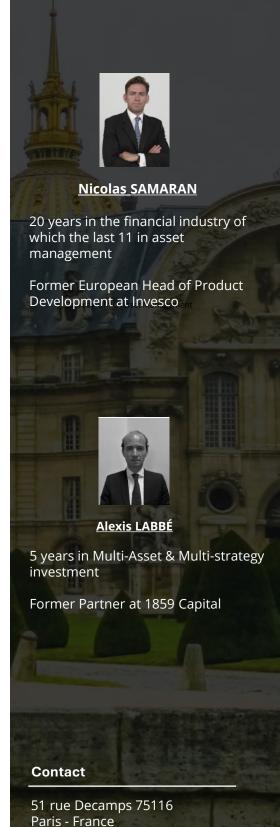
